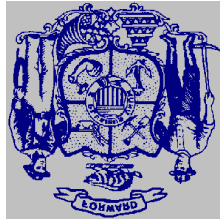

LISTING OF PROGRAMS, SERVICES AND OPERATIONS

The purpose of this document is to provide a summary of various organized activities provided for offenders under the custody and supervision of the Wisconsin Department of Corrections, consistent with its mission to ensure the safety and protection of the public. A 1997-8 survey of all divisions resulted in the lists of activities produced. It was determined that the most realistic approach to defining all the activities was to categorize them in three areas: Programs, Services and Operations. Programs are categorized and further defined as *Essential* or *Supportive*.

There are six major categories of Programs, with 25 sub-groups located in 645 delivery sites throughout the state. It is recognized that such definitional categorization may in certain instances be debated. However, this listing uses the assessed needs of offenders as the major defining component. This listing will be updated annually.

PROGRAMS: a prescribed set of time-limited activities and implementation processes that research has shown to ameliorate factors specifically related to criminal behavior and recidivism risk in a specified offender population. Program needs are identified and prioritized during the assessment and evaluation process, and by the program review committees within the institutions.

A program is characterized by a formal program statement that addresses the program's overall purpose and design. A program statement includes the following components: goals and objectives; activities that will achieve those goals and objectives; staff involved; and an evaluation design that includes performance measures and data collection.

Essential programs: are identified by a distinctive set of standards, regulations, policies and procedures that direct implementation and operation. These programs are coordinated by a unique set of persons specializing in the provision of activities.

Essential Programs: *Alcohol & Other Drug Abuse, Child Abuse Prevention, Cognitive Restructuring & Social Skills Training,*

Domestic Violence Offender, Education - Literacy, Sex Offender.

Supportive programs: assist offenders in the application, maintenance and internalization of skills learned in essential programs.

Supportive Programs: *Aftercare Support Groups, Pre-Treatment/Deniers.*

SERVICES: an accommodation, form of assistance or activity provided to and for offenders, to assure their physical, medical, psychiatric, social and spiritual well-being. Services may also be provided to enhance the effectiveness of correctional programming and may be time limited or ongoing. Federal/state statutes, administrative rules or internal management procedures govern the provision of services.

Services: *Canteen, Correctional Enterprises, Employment, Education - Vocational, Legal, Library, Medical and Dental, Psychological, Recreational, Religious, Social Service and Visitation.*

OPERATIONS: an ongoing process, procedure or duty necessary for the efficient operation, orderly functioning and safety of a correctional institution and the community at large. Operations may be statutorily required or mandated by administrative rules. Operations manuals define the rules and regulations, responsibilities, and reporting hierarchy governing a particular operation. They may also define specific strategies, methodologies or performance standards for carrying out the operation.

Operations: *Collections and Financial Records, Community Work Projects, Work Assignments, Facility Maintenance, Offender Classification, Security.*

DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS

DEFINITIONS OF AODA PROGRAM LEVELS

LEVEL 1 SUPPORT GROUPS

Support groups are open ended groups (which means a slot is refilled with another offender when one offender leaves) that are intended to provide a non-judgmental atmosphere in which individuals can discuss the issues affecting their lives and their recovery from chemically dependency. The philosophies and methods of each support group differ and one can choose the group that fits his or her personal needs and lifestyle. All of these organizations encourage complete abstinence from alcohol and other drugs.

LEVEL 2 AFTERCARE

Aftercare is sometimes described as "continuing care." The term *aftercare* presumes that an earlier, *primary* care treatment experience has taken place. Thus, upon successfully completing a primary care treatment program, clients are sometimes referred to an aftercare component of care.

LEVEL 3 OUTPATIENT TREATMENT

"An outpatient treatment program provides a variety of non-residential evaluation, diagnostic and treatment services related to alcohol or drug abuse to ameliorate or remove a disability and to restore effective functioning. Services include but are not limited to family counseling, group therapy, vocational guidance and referral which may occur on a scheduled or non-scheduled basis over an extended period of time." (WI Adm. Code - HSS 61.59)

LEVEL 4 DAY TREATMENT / INTENSIVE OUT-PATIENT PROGRAMS

Day treatment is *"a non-residential program in a medically supervised setting that services adults or children with alcohol or other drug problems and that provides case management, counseling, medical care and therapies on a routine basis for a scheduled portion of a 24-hour day and a scheduled number of days per week to alleviate those problems. Services include individual, family and group counseling." (WI Adm. Code - HSS 61.61)*

Within the Department of Corrections, day treatment program models vary but in general they provide a comprehensive array of services designed to reduce criminality as well as substance abuse. Day treatment services include individual and group counseling, surveillance and support services. Each of the day treatment programs is required to provide a component that specifically addresses the alcohol/drug abuse needs of offenders. Additional program components are designed to address problems that accompany the offender's substance abuse.

LEVEL 5 RESIDENTIAL / IN-PATIENT PROGRAMS

A residential treatment program is *"a live-in facility which operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and is staffed by professional and para-professional persons who offer a therapeutic program for alcohol or drug dependent persons or both." (WI Adm. Code - HSS 61.60)*

LEVEL 5A RESIDENTIAL - LOW LITERACY

These programs are designed for individuals whose academic or intellectual impairments render it unlikely that they would benefit from other residential treatment programs. These impairments may result from developmental delays, learning disabilities, head trauma or other brain dysfunction and educational deficiencies. Individualized treatment plans identify each offender's academic or intellectual deficits and modify the delivery and content of the treatment materials to address these problems. A major emphasis of treatment program focuses on problem solving and day-to-day decision making. These programs utilize a variety of alternative learning strategies such as re-statement and repetition, role playing, behavioral rehearsal and computer enhanced instruction to enhance the client's treatment experience.

LEVEL 5B RESIDENTIAL - COGNITIVE / BEHAVIORAL

These residential treatment programs utilize a cognitive based approach to chemical dependency treatment. Treatment programs in this category focus on alcohol and drug problems, criminal thinking, rational behavior and the dynamics of personal change. Program components assist clients in identifying values, beliefs and thinking patterns that have contributed to their drug related and anti-social behaviors. Through the treatment process, clients begin to replace negative, irrational and dysfunctional thinking patterns with more constructive, rational and goal-oriented thinking patterns.

LEVEL 5C RESIDENTIAL - COGNITIVE / SOCIAL SKILLS BASED

These residential programs are similar in content to cognitive/behavioral programs (Level 5B) and combine both educational and counseling techniques. They frequently use assertiveness training and role playing as tools of change. Rational emotive therapy and criminal thinking modules are also generally incorporated into the program format. Alcohol abuse education and alcoholism in the family are significant components in these programs.

LEVEL 5D RESIDENTIAL - DUALY DIAGNOSED

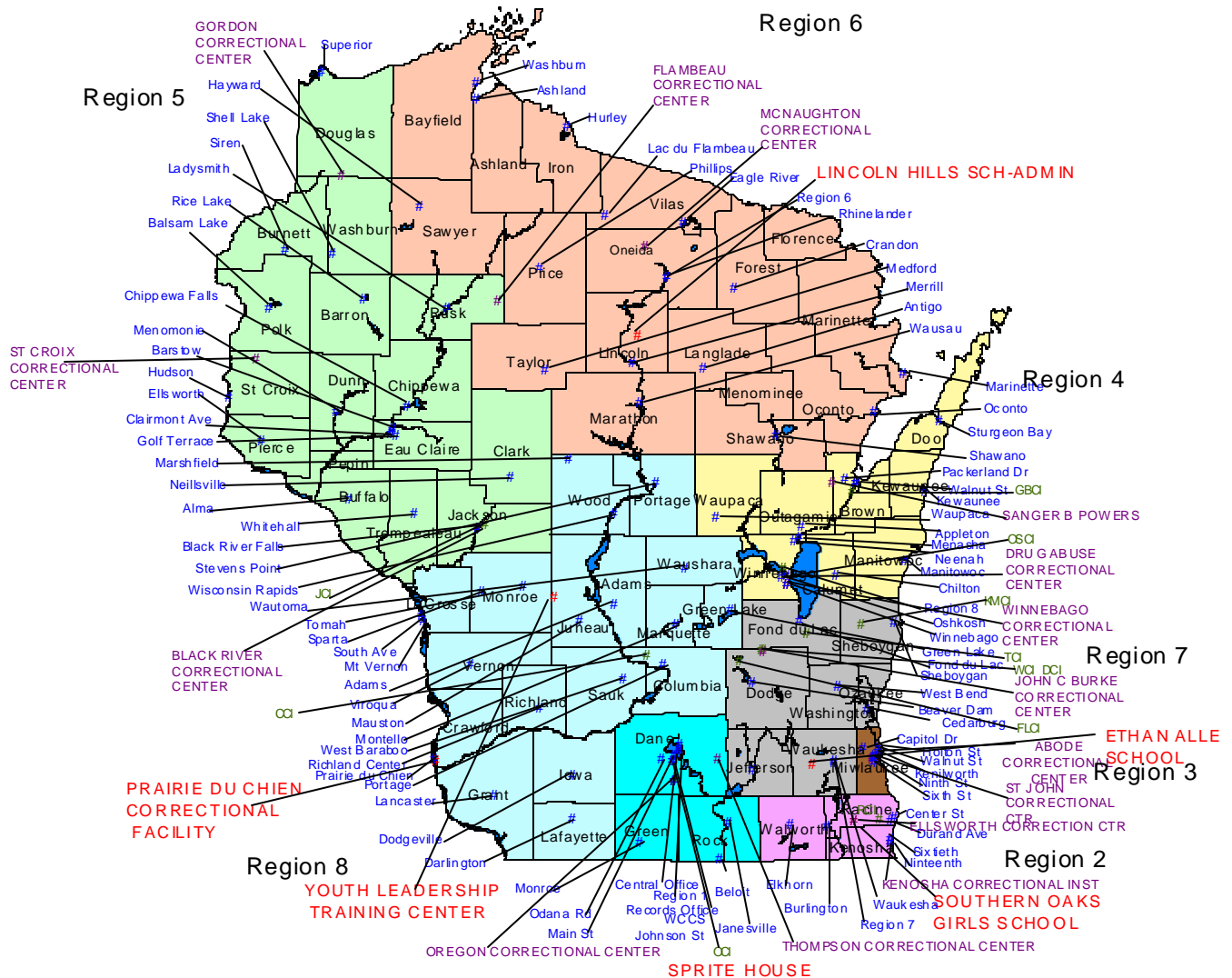
These programs integrate the addiction and psychiatric models of recovery or rehabilitation in a process of growth despite the presence of a chronic, incurable mental illness. Both models emphasize that the process of recovery requires focusing not merely on stabilizing the more prominent aspects of the mental illness and drug addiction but engaging the person in active participation in the treatment and rehabilitation process. These models introduce a parallel process of recovery which include phases of acute stabilization (acute psychotic symptoms are stabilized with medication and detoxification from substances takes place), engagement (establishing a beginning treatment relationship, educating the person about the illness/addiction, teaching the how to comply with treatment and overcome denial and other resistances), prolonged stabilization (attaining maximum possible symptom control through on-going medication compliance and maintaining complete abstinence) and rehabilitation (continued active participation in treatment which focuses on social and vocational rehabilitation.)

LEVEL 6 THERAPEUTIC COMMUNITY

These residential programs are generally long term (six months or longer) and are the most restrictive and structured of those offering a 24 hour a day treatment milieu. They are designed to challenge and modify the anti-social thinking which is so closely related to the substance abuse of the client served by these programs. A holistic approach to change is taken to promote change in all aspects of the client's life. Treatment interventions are designed to encourage and develop social awareness. These programs tend to be highly

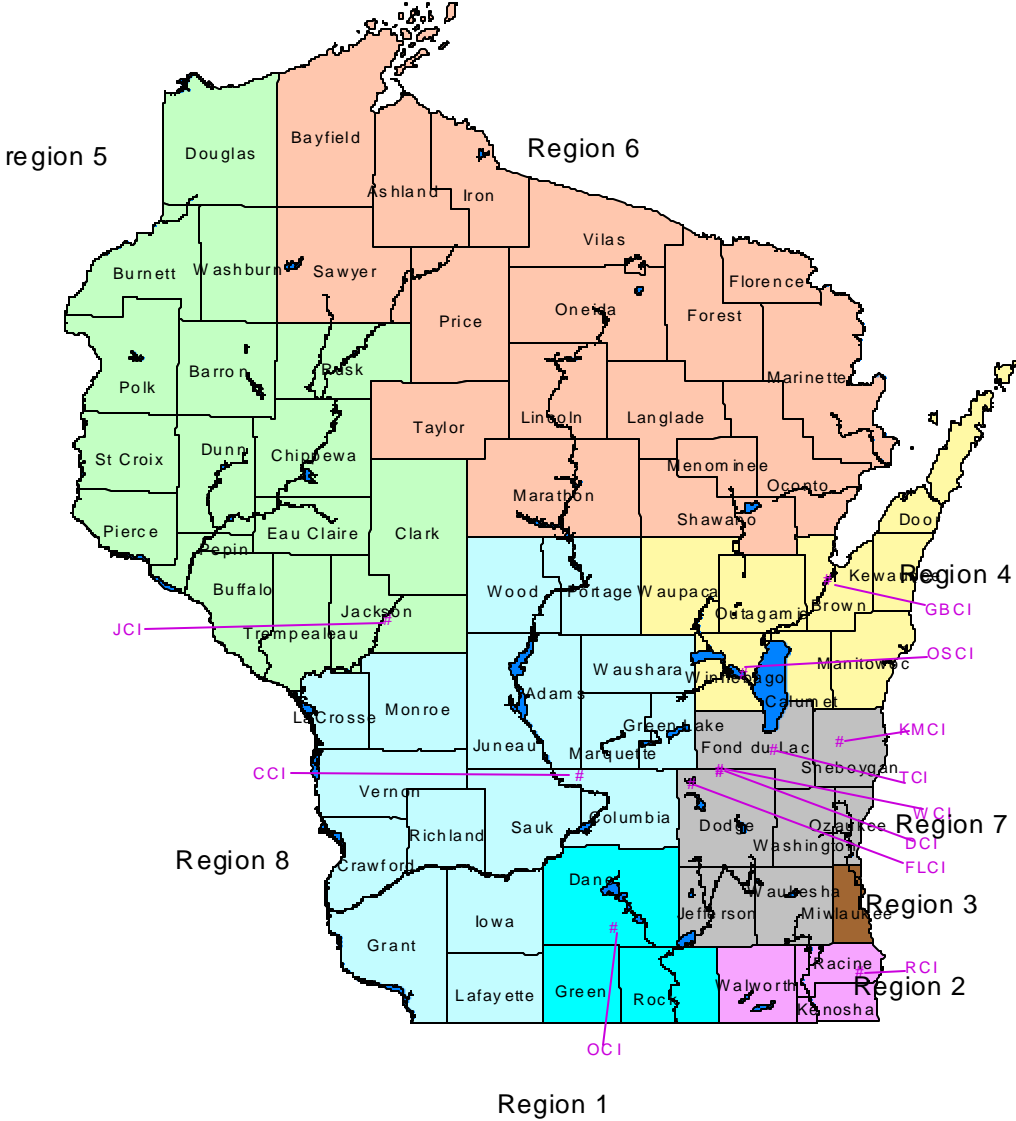
confrontive in nature and utilize group pressure and other techniques to compel clients to recognize and strive alter their anti-social behavior and redirect them toward more pro-social goals.

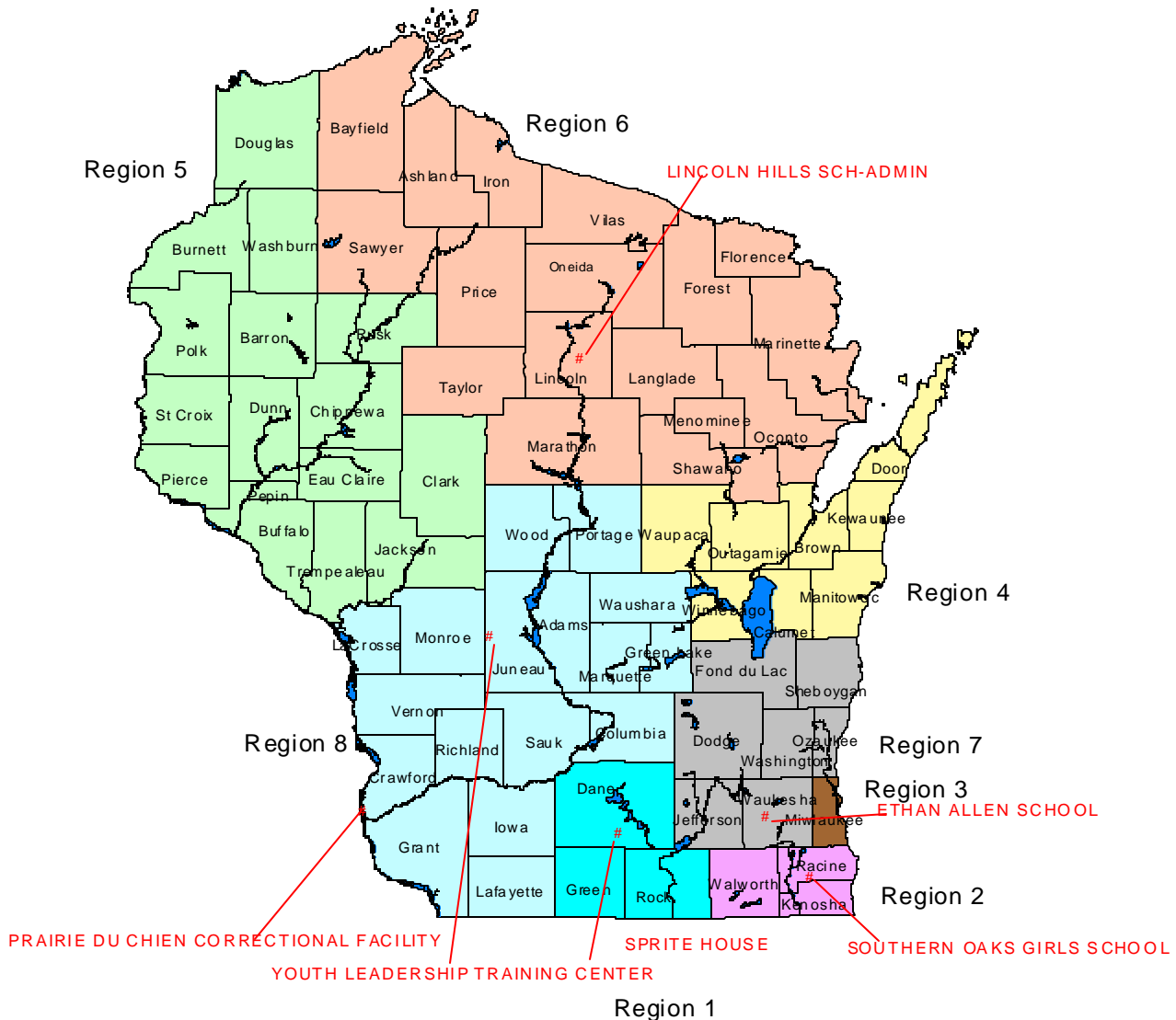
