² Population counts include inmates physically present at 12:00 A.M. plus reported beds held. This reporting policy applies to all DOC adult inmate facilities and both in- and out-of-state contracted beds.

³ Midnight Count includes all juvenile offenders "inside the fence" at each institution at Midnight Thursday.
