<sup>1</sup> Operating capacity is defined as the original design capacity of the institution, based on industry standards, plus modifications and expansions. It excludes beds and multiple bunking that were instituted to accommodate crowding.

<sup>2</sup> Population counts include inmates physically present at 12:00 A.M. plus reported beds held. This reporting policy applies to all DOC adult inmate facilities and both in- and out-of-state contracted beds.

<sup>3</sup> Midnight Count includes all juvenile offenders "inside the fence" at each institution at Midnight Thursday.
